2. Measures taken to complete the syllabus of courses and programs.

Covid 19 pandemic was found to incur devastating loss to society but it has proved to be a blessings in disguise to bring about a metamorphic change in terms of technological advancement in terms of digital education. Our Institute has adopted itself to this rapid change in online education in terms of providing quality outcome based education to our students at diploma, degree, postgraduate and doctoral level. This has led NIET to receive QS I-Gauge E-Lead Award by Honourable Minister of Education Dr. Ramesh Pokhrial for its outstanding contribution for providing quality online education. To establish a video-based learning platform to enable faculty members to capture, edit, and distribute content, the Institute signed a MoUs with Impartus. Bangalore and Microsoft Corporation, 100% of the faculty members used Zoom, Microsoft and Google meet platform to take an online class of the students during this pandemic period when classes could not be conducted in offline mode due to Government regulations. Thus we conducted online theory classes for all students of Pharmacy programmes starting from Diploma to post graduation using Microsoft as digital platform. PPTs were distributed along with question banks to students before the commencement of classes through ERP Institute ID and passwords.. All practical classes were conducted using virtual platform by recorded laboratory classes, You tubes videos and online demonstration of experiments conducted by faculty members. Regular Tutorials and quizzes were also conducted where the students submitted their answer copies online which were evaluated by faculty members and returned online. Special classes were also conducted for weak students to clarify their doubts during evening hours. To augment the online delivery through technical tools, 36 faculty members used digital writing pads. The faculty mentors took care of their mentees in regards to psychological strength and guidance by online meets. To keep the training activities on track, the Pyramid Finishing School conducted 21 online sessions on soft skills and personality development with the final year students, and 21 online placement drives were conducted. Online workshops, 2 FDPs under ATAL scheme of AICTE, 2 online FDP sponsored by AICTE and 1 online FDP sponsored by AKTU, Lucknow were conducted in various upcoming areas like Design Thinking, 3D Printing, Artificial Intelligence in healthcare etc. More than 285 faculty members from different Pharmacy Institutes of India have participated in online FDPs. More than 18 activities were conducted by our Pharmacy Institute Innovation cell(IIC) to ignite students' research attitude where more than 1200 students participated in these events. Our faculty members have taken a leading role in the development of MOOCS lectures for all subjects of BPharm (Even and Odd Sem) on behalf of Dr APJ Abdul Kalam Technical University which are accessed by students not only of our state but also by students of various parts of India through Shyam Prabha Channels, DISH TV and You tubes. Our efforts in this direction were warmly appreciated and responded to by all stakeholders. Thus, we succeeded in uninterrupted conduction of the teaching-learning process.
